Become a Registered Childcare Provider

NOTE: It is illegal in the State of Michigan to care for unrelated children in your home without being licensed or registered by the Department of Licensing & Regulatory Affairs

1. **Complete the Child Development and Care Unlicensed Provider Application.** Return pages 1-3, keep page 4 for your records. Find the application at www.michigan.gov/childcare
2. **Proof of identity.** Acceptable verifications include:
 - Current, valid Driver's License
 - Federal, state, or local government-issued ID
 - U.S. passport
 - School issued ID with photograph
 - Form I-551, Green Card or Alien Registration Card
3. **Proof of age**
4. **Copy of valid Social Security Card**
5. **Proof of residential and/or mailing address.** Acceptable verification includes:
 - ID which provides name and address
 - Current mortgage or rent receipt
 - Current utility bill showing service at the address
 - Current pay stubs with name and address
 - Current homeowner's insurance policy
6. **Attend required Health and Safety Training**

Apply for the DHHS Childcare Subsidy

You may qualify for Michigan's Child Development and Care subsidy program that will pay for part of your childcare costs if you need child care while you are engaged in: employment, high school completion, or family preservation.
